

Women In The Old Testament Study Set

This study has 10 sessions, incorporating an introductory session and 9 lessons. The Study Set includes the Study Guide by Catherine Upchurch and a commentary, <u>Women in the Old Testament</u>, by Irene Nowell (Liturgical Press).

While the men of the Old Testament often garner the most attention, the women of the Old Testament become all the more worthy of our interest because we have to dig deeper to recover their special contribution to the annals of faith. Their stories are all the more remarkable in that they arise from historical eras that crimped their


options in influencing or changing the flow of history. The women of this study can be bold and decisive, also meek and faithful, but they are always compelled to act in ways that bring about change. God's saving deeds often came through the mind and will of amazing women using limited resources. The study will look at the women from Israel's beginnings, Passover and the early tribes up through Israel's Monarchy. Special attention will be given to women of courage and strength, in particular Queen Esther.


Women In The New Testament Study Set

This study has 8 sessions, incorporating an introductory session and 7 lessons. The Study Set includes the Study Guide by Catherine Upchurch and a commentary, <u>Women in the New Testament</u>, by Mary Ann Getty-Sullivan (Liturgical Press).

This study of New Testament women engages with women across a variety of connections to Jesus and the apostles and studies them accordingly. Participants will encounter the strengths and needs of these women, but

also how being a woman in the holy land during the time of Jesus and the apostles shaped many of the challenges they faced in responding to Jesus. Participants will enter into discussion and prayer about expectant faith, what it means to be touched by Jesus, and the meaning of discipleship through the lives of the women who lived in the first generation of Christianity.

Panorama of the Old Testament Study Set

This study has 5 sessions. The Study Set includes the Study Guide by Catherine Upchurch and a commentary *Panorama of the Bible: Old Testament* by Stephen J. Binz.

Panorama of the New Testament Study Set

This study has 5 sessions and includes the Study Guide by Catherine Upchurch and a commentary *Panorama of the Bible: New Testament* by Stephen J. Binz.

You are invited to enter the biblical story of the New Testament beginning with the gospels and working your way through the final book, Revelation. Discover God's plan of salvation running throughout the story and characters, both familiar and unfamiliar.
