**AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS:

TEACCH Transition Assessment Profile-2
(TTAP-2)**

This training is designed for professional staff who need to assess skill levels and acquisition to enable more appropriate IEP goal and post-secondary transition planning.

The PEP-3 provides a developmental frame- work; a way to describe and understand the characteristic uneven learning patterns seen in children with autism and related developmental disorders, for children who function developmentally ages 6 mo. To 7 yrs.

The TTAP-2 is a comprehensive test for children with ASD, ages 8-adulthood, that identifies the individual's principle transition goals, strengths, and weaknesses. It can be used for ongoing assessment in community- based instruction and can be used to facilitate educational and transition planning in the major areas of vocational skills; vocational behavior; independent functioning; leisure skills; functional communication; and inter-personal behavior. Learner Outcomes include:

- Basic knowledge of PEP-3 and TTAP-2 administration, scoring and interpretation
- Use of PEP-3 results to identify emerging skills, special learning strengths, and autistic behavioral characteristics
- Use of TTAP-2 to assess for transition
- Use of TTAP-2 to identify transitional goals, strengths and weaknesses in 6 major functional areas
- Use of TTAP-2for on-going assessment in community-based instruction
