<u>Contract Work Items.</u> This work includes, but is not limited to, designing, furnishing and installing all materials to construct a pre-engineered (metal frame) building and completing necessary sitework.

<u>Contract Time.</u> The Owner has established a contract performance time of 180 consecutive calendar days from the date of the Notice-To-Proceed for all project work. All project work shall be substantially completed within the stated timeframe. This project is subject to liquidated damages as prescribed within the Project Manual.

<u>Bid Security.</u> Each Bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code, in the amount stated and payable to the order of the Owner. The Bid security shall be in the form of either
