

2016 PROPOSAL

During our time in Guatemala, we visited an orphanage (Casa Shalom) where we provided the 90 children that live there a day of fun with inflatable slides and ice cream. We also toured Thrive Coffee hosted by Edgar Cabrera. While touring the estate, we discovered another opportunity to partner with Thrive Coffee in 2016. Thrive Coffee operates a school for the children of those who work on the estate. As we visited the school Juan Fernando told us his vision to improve the school and offer the children a better education. The school also provides lunch for the children each day. Our entrepreneurial minds began to generate ideas of how we could make a difference through our partnership with Thrive Coffee, Chick-fil-A and LifeShape International. We felt we had a natural fit with Thrive and saw an opportunity to return and conduct some LifeShape International Projects associated with the refurbishing of the school on the grounds of the estate. 
RELATIONSHIPS
