

For the months of Jan. and Feb., we will be reading a book called <u>Something</u>


<u>Other Than God</u> by Jennifer Fulwiler.

where we will say a prayer at 10am, then go for a short run (walk or bike) on the Rails to Trails. The social hall will be open for water.




Join us for a Potluck Sunday Lunch every 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday immediately following the 11am
