

ORDINANCE # 314-2019

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019, SETTING THE TAX RATE AT \$0.2117 PER \$100.00 OF ASSESSED VALUATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEPHERD, SAN JACINTO COUNTY, TEXAS:

At a called meeting of the City Council of the City of Shepherd, Texas, on September 9, 2019, Yvonne Cones made a motion, Shannon Bailey seconded and the following voted aye, Councilpersons Mark Porter and Amanda Addison

The Tax Rate of the tax year 2017-2018 was set at the rate of \$0.2456 per \$100.00 of Assessed Valuation for the following:

- Maintenance & Operation

This tax rate will raise the same revenue for Maintenance and Operations as last year's tax rate because of increased property values

By adopting the effective tax rate of \$0.2117 per \$100 of value, tax revenue will increase in comparison to 2018

These taxes are levied for the support of the Municipal government of the City of Shepherd, Texas for the fiscal year 2019-2020.

All delinquent taxes are subject to penalty, interest and cost after delinquency.

This ordinance becomes effective immediately.


Any previous ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed AND IT IS SO ORDAINED on this the 9th day of September, 2019.
