Payment through Game Officials GoPay

All referees need to have a **W-9** and **Workers Comp Waiver** on file with the City of Novi. Novi Parks pays referees through GoPay and the payment will occur within one week following the games. Referees have the option to receive payment as a direct deposit to a bank account or by check. Direct deposit is highly recommended. This setting can be adjusted in the referee's Game Officials User Account.

BONUS Program

The BONUS program rewards those officials who regularly work Novi Parks' soccer games. Referees will receive the BONUS within two weeks following the conclusion of the season.

Misconduct: Coaches, Players, and Spectators
