### **Music Notes**

The opening and closing voluntaries are by Felix Mendelssohn (1809-1847). The “Andante” is in the style of a chorale, consisting of almost only half-notes. This grand statement in D Major is followed by the closing voluntary, “Andante con moto.” This work takes place in B Minor, and moves along in a lilting 6/8 time signature.

Mendelssohn, who was raised in the Jewish faith, became a Christian in his early adulthood. His faith can be seen most clearly in his Oratorio writings, such as “St. Paul” and “Elijah.” His compositional style is modeled most clearly after Bach, who we wouldn’t celebrate today if it wasn’t for Mendelssohn reviving his works.
