



REACH - Letter of Intent

To Our Customers,

On 10/28/08, the ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) published the first official list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) known as the Candidate List. Since that time the list has been amended to 84 substances.

Currently, there are 54 substances that are under review as potential additions to the Candidate List. Nationwide has already determined itself to be in full compliance with the current list of SVHC's as well as the 54 proposed substances.
