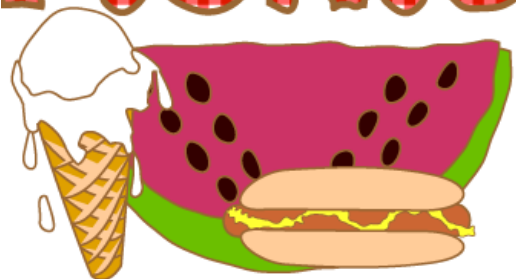

Phone Tree Call List: The current phone tree call list has been updated by removing several names and changing

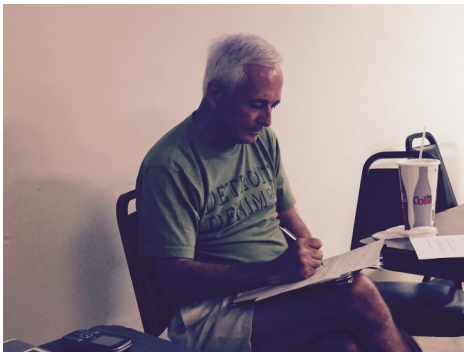
responsibility for calling members who do not have e-mail access.

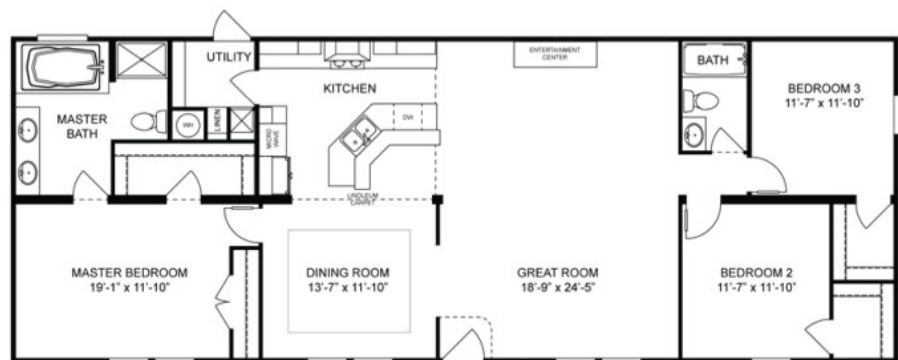

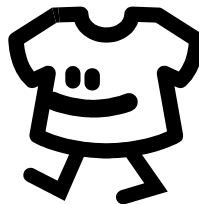

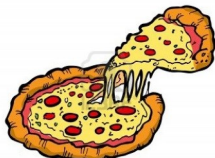
