High School Guidelines for Submitting to the Harry Potter Academic Conference

Deadline: September 20, 2024

High school students are encouraged to submit papers to the High School Section of the Harry Potter Conference which will be held on Saturday, October 19. The conference welcomes papers which address almost every aspect of the Harry Potter series, however past papers have focused on analyses of characters/themes in the Harry Potter series, or a discussion of how the Harry Potter series extends into an academic discipline.

If your paper is accepted for the 2024 conference, you will be invited to read your paper at the High School conference section on Saturday, October 19. Please indicate your availability to present at the conference at the beginning of your essay as shown below. (Scholarships are awarded based on the essay writing, not on the presentation/reading of the essay.)

- 1. Complete the submission form (note: high schoolers are not required to submit an abstract)
- 2. Email your paper to harrypotterconference@chc.edu

High School Papers must comply with the following guidelines:

Length: 2–5 pages, 12-point Times New Roman font, 1-inch margins (not including personal information provided), submitted to harrypotterconference@chc.edu.

Include at the beginning of your essay: your full name and address, a contact phone number for a parent/guardian, your email address, your high school name and location, your current class year (i.e. sophomore, senior), and your availability to present at the High School conference section on October 19.
