



REFLECTION



I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I AM the gate.

Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. Today's gospel says, the shepherd of the sheep enters through the gate and his sheep follows him because they recognize his voice. They will not fol-

low a stranger because they do not recognize the strangers voice. Jesus is trying to tell them that he is the gate of the sheep and the sheep did not listen to the thieves and robbers who came before him. Whoever enters through him will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. This parable describes the relationship of Jesus with all of us. He knows us intimately. He knows our strengths and weaknesses. In spite of our weaknesses, Jesus is patient with us and waits for us even when we do not follow him. He waits for each of us to come to him and have a personal relationship with him. Even though we sin if we ask for his forgiveness, we can be saved and can follow Jesus into heaven.
