Betcher gave an update on the progress at Cardinal Field renovations. \$65,000 in funding has been secured from Village of Dryden, Dryden Community Schools and Township of Dryden which also includes a grant from the Lapeer Optimist Club of \$5,000. Lapeer County Foundation has pledge funding if the balance needed can be raised. The Four County Foundation is currently considering a grant proposal.

The committee hopes to have the Pavillion constructed and the walk path in place by early summer. The Bathrooms may follow depending on the final budget.
