

Guidelines for Those Wishing to Present at HOLMES, DOYLE, & FRIENDS

✓ The Committee must have a précis (summary) of your presentation by 31 January. We don't need the whole thing, though that certainly would be welcome, but a title *alone* is unacceptable. Also un-

acceptable are presentations that consist primarily of advertising for merchandise or books. Confine sales pitches to the vendors' tables. Please wire (Holmesians *never* use the term "e-mail") your précis in any format readable by Microsoft Word® to Dan Andriacco:

- ✓ All decisions of the Committee are *final*. If your paper is accepted, you'll be entitled to a reduced Conference fee, as specified on the Registration Form.
- There will be a screen and digital projector with both VGA and HDMI inputs for those using Power Point® or similar programs, and a desktop computer using the Windows 10 operating system. Apple® users: please bring your own machines, or use the "export" option to save your slides to a flash drive or CD-ROM in a format readable by Windows.®
- Presentations will be limited to twenty (20) minutes. This includes questions, and will be strictly enforced. A rule of thumb is that it takes about seventy-five (75) seconds to read a double-spaced page in fixed space (sometimes called "monospace") type. Thus, your presentation should be about twelve (12) double-spaced pages to allow a few minutes for questions or discussion at the end. Single-spaced or proportionally spaced text takes more time.
