### **WEEKLY THOUGHTS SUNDAY OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD JESUS JAN.10-21**

Dear friends, last Sunday we celebrated the Sunday of the Epiphany of the Lord- when Jesus was revealed to the nation as the Light and Savior of the world to the three kings or wise men. Today, we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord which actually marks the beginning of his public ministry. It is also another Epiphany- the heavens are being open and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him. And the voice come from the heavens, "You are my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased."

Many of us were baptized when young or babies. Jesus however came to John to be baptized as an adult. Jesus exhibited a sign of humility as he accepted John's Baptism for he had no sins to confess before John.
