The Commissioners of the City of Horton met for a special meeting on Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. in the City Hall Commission Room.

Mayor Lentz called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

Present: Mayor Lentz, Commissioners Krug, Stirton, and Barton, and Edwards. Kim Clausen was also present.

Workshop to Discuss Various Projects and Topics Happening in Horton

Mayor Lentz talked about the next steps for the downtown improvements that he would like to see happen. The topic of constructing a new pool for the city of Horton, and possibly placing it on the ballot to let the citizen's vote was also brought up.

211 West 11th Street has a sewer main running under it that needs improvements. The city will incur around \$1800.00 of this cost, while the remaining amount will fall under the USDA contract.

Brian Nyp, Todd Burrus, Scott Shreve, and Sarah Jacobson joined the meeting to discuss upgrading the cities generators. This would provide, install, and make operational RICE NESHAP Oxidation Catalysts including data monitoring, crankcase ventilation, compliance testing, and operator training for all 4 units. They also discussed converting three of the units to dual fuel capability.

The Commission asked for Todd Burrus to prepare the paperwork and Resolution for a Revenue Bond to cover the costs of the upgrades.

Motion by Commissioner Edwards to adjourn the meeting at 11:56 a.m. Seconded by Commissioner Barton. All aye.
