Yeshivah Prep provides its students with an educational experience aligned with the frameworks and standards of the New York State high school curriculum. Our goal is to equip our students with the knowledge and skills they need to graduate with a New York Regents diploma and to prepare them for college and/or careers.

Our classes are comprised of small student to teacher ratios offering our students opportunities to receive individualized instruction. Smaller class sizes allow teachers to address each student's specific needs, enabling them to reach their full potential. Our staff is compromised of a team of professional teachers and rabbis as well as a guidance counselor. Yeshivah Prep graduates emerge as self-aware, confident young adults possessing the skills they need to succeed.

At Yeshivah Prep we offer an extensive array of programs including, but not limited to: Regent prep classes, Jewish Hebrew curriculum, CPR, first aid and nutrition, foreign language, public speaking, journalism, psychology, art, music instruction, physical education, safe health education, field trips, Senior year internships, and college guidance. Our students participate in many socialization and educational programs with Yeshivah of Flatbush High School. Throughout the day students walk the short distance between the high school facilities to take part in peer activities. Some of these programs include school assemblies, youth seminars, daily minyan, Rosh Hodesh Kumzitz, hesed opportunities, clubs and sports teams.

Yeshivah Prep provides rigorous college preparatory instruction. Students are assisted with the many college and/or career choices commensurate with their interests and abilities. In addition, professional guidance counselors help students and families navigate the college admittance process. The Senior Year Internship Program eases the transition from the classroom to the professional world. Past internships include teaching, journalism, legal assistant, sales, medicine, reception and more. We even had a student intern for State Senator Simcha Felder!

As the students enter eleventh and twelfth grades, they begin to set goals for their future. It is especially rewarding to observe and see the students accomplish what they set out to ie. captain of the swim team in YOF, gaining acceptance to College of Drama of NY, entering the Israeli army...
