Harry graduated from Ubly High School. He enlisted in the US Army and was deployed to Vietnam having done two tours of duty. Harry was a decorated veteran. He earned the Army Service Ribbon, National Defense Service Medal with Bronze Service Star, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon, Army Good Conduct Medal, Army Achievement Medal (First Leaf Oak Cluster), Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross with Palm, Vietnam Service Medal and Expert Badge (Rifle and Pistol). Harry was also member of the VFW Post #116 of Bad Axe. Harry retired from Tandom Transport after receiving his Million Miler award for driving over one million miles accident free.
