

Prismatic Star Supply List and Pre-Class

This beautiful quilt uses Bali Pops 48 strip (2 1/2") pack which are pre-arranged into 6 sets of 8 strips from dark to light or you can create your own and background fabric. Strips are sewn (paper pieced) onto foundation paper to complete what we call a 'Strip Set'. After the strip sets are completed, they are cut apart, rearranged and resewn into a diamond star point. Super fun! If you took one of the paper piecing

Rule of thumb: When choosing fabrics, it is best **not** to have directional fabrics

Supplies

- ◆ Prismatic Star Pattern by Judy Niemeyer
- ◆ Fabric Yardage Listed on Pattern Sheet (48 strip pack, 1 ¼ yard sashing, 2 yards background)
- ◆ Water Soluble Fabric Glue **Pen (not liquid)**
- ◆ UHU Glue Stick or water soluble glue stick
- ◆ (8) One or Two Gallon Size Ziplock bags labeled (#1 - #8) Plus one extra for scraps (labeled PS Scraps)
- ◆ One box of Large Paper clips, a pencil, scotch tape and a stapler comes in handy
- ◆ Template Plastic for a folding template
- ◆ Add a Quarter ruler – 12" (18" is also fine)
- ◆ Purple Thang
- ◆ Quilting Ruler
- ◆ Small Iron and ironing pad
- ◆ Rotary cutter (with a new blade in it!)
- ◆ Rotary cutting mat
- ◆ Fabric scissors and paper scissors
- ◆ Flat head pins (best for paper piecing)
- ◆ Sewing machine (Don't forget the power supply and foot pedal! If you have a 1/4" foot, please bring it.)
- ◆ Sewing supplies
 - *Thread – color that will blend with your fabrics. I recommend *Aurifil in a cream color.
 - Bobbins – it's best to fill several bobbins with the appropriate color thread prior to class
 - *Seam ripper

Pre-Class Instructions

- Label 8 ziplock bags #1- #8 - plus one extra bag labeled..."Scraps"
- If you purchased the 48 strip set, you are done. If not, arrange your strips in 6 sets of 8 strips with each set being from light to dark. (Do not come to class with out this step done)
