- League size will be limited to 20 teams. League members can add new teams after approval by the captains if such an opening occurs after the spring meeting. This shall be voted on at the fall meeting.
- The boundary lines for a team in the league are within a five mile radius of the Fond du Lac County line.
- The fall meeting is the deadline to sign up all teams. A team representative must be present at both the spring and fall meeting. If no one is present there will be a \$20.00 fine assessed to the team which will be taken out at the end of the year from their winning money.
- Two elected officers, the President and the Secretary/Treasurer shall govern the league. The officer's term is one year; however, their terms can be renewed each year with a majority vote by the league members at the Spring Meeting.
- A rules Committee shall be made up of all the Captains. Only one vote per team is allowed when voting on rule changes. Rules will be discussed at the Spring meeting and then voted on at the fall meeting.
- Prize money will be paid out by wins not by percentages. All prize check must be cashed within 90 days of being received or they will be voided.
- The sportsmanship plaque is a traveling trophy
- Shooters may only play on one team per year on this league.

LEAGUE FEE'S

- **Sponsor's Fees:** All sponsors shall pay a yearly fee of \$35.00 per team. This fee must be received by the end of the first month of the season otherwise there will be an extra \$20.00 fine added for a total of \$55.00 owed by the bar.
- **Weekly Fee's:** \$20.00 per team. Each team must pay \$5.00 per player, including subs, each game night. Even in the case of forfeit. That money, \$40.00 per match, is to be sent to the treasurer by Friday of that week or fines could result.

CALL THE POCKET

- Players must verbally call the ball to the pocket.
- If you make your last two balls on the same shot the ball called will be your last pocket.
- If your opponent makes your last ball, you should call your pocket AFTER they finish shooting, not when it falls.
- Once a player touches the table they are in charge of it. If a hanging 8 ball falls in any pocket but your last pocket after establishing control of the table, it is loss of game.
- If an honest (blatant) attempt is not made at the object ball it is considered a loss of game.

EIGHT BALL REGULATIONS

- Eight ball drop on the break without scratching is considered a win.
- Eight ball popped off the table is a loss.
- Sinking the eight ball in the wrong pocket or early is a loss.
- Scratching when making the eight ball is a loss.
- If the cue ball is touching a rail it is considered dead and cannot be used as a first rail on a three rail.
- The eight ball is never a neutral ball.
- Knocking the eight ball out of your opponents called pocket without first touching one of your object balls will be a loss.
- Calling, then railing the eight ball, three or more times into that pocket is a win.
- You may call then three rail the cue ball into the eight ball into any pocket.
- Shooters may not make their last ball and the eight ball on the same shot, to do so is loss of game.

BANQUET

- The league will pay for five dinners per team; any additional meals will be deducted from team winnings along with no shows under the five if not given at least a 48 hour notice.

SPONSOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for providing a pool table that's adequately lit and a cloth that's clean and serviceable.
- Provide four reasonably good cue sticks and sufficient chalk and powder.
- Sponsors are required to keep non-participating patrons from disturbing the games; failure to do so will result in a loss of the game for the home team.
- Sponsors are required to provide a granny stick.
- Traveling plaque is the bar's responsibility. If it is lost they will need to replace it.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Starting time will be 7:00 PM unless contacted by the opposing team and then start time will be 7:30 PM
- One player must be there from teams by 7:00. Players will shoot out of rotation if need be. No forfeit will occur until play cannot continue then forfeit will happen in 10 minute intervals until play can resume.

CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collect all fees due from that nights play.
- Enter the line-up on the score sheets.
- Note any table runs in the comments section on the score sheets, and circle the game in which it occurred.
- Sign and Total the score sheets at the end of the match.
- Home team Captain's send the score sheets and fees collected from both teams to the treasurer the next day. If the envelope is not postmarked by the

following Monday a \$20.00 fine will be given to the home team. This money will come out of that team's winnings at the end of the season.

- A check would be preferable to cash, as the captain would have proof that the fees were sent and a way to recoup the money if it was lost in the mail. The home team is liable for any moneys not received.
- Make checks payable to Fond du Lac County Pool League.
- If for any reason a match is postponed, it should be made up before the next scheduled match. Please notify the sec/treasurer of any postponements.
- In the event of a tie during the championship match each team picks a shooter and then flip for the break of the match.

ROTATION

- Home team rotates and racks the first and third round.
- Visiting team shoots in order and racks the second and fourth.

RULES OF PLAY

- Players cannot solicit advice nor can teammates or patrons offer advice to a player while the game is in play. To do so would result in the loss of the game.
- The cue ball must be all the way in the kitchen on the break or after a scratch.
- After a scratch, the first rail hit cannot be inside of the kitchen.
- If a player missed the rack on the break they shoot over.
- No intentional Jumping over another ball, to do so will be a loss of shot.
- Players will have a total of two minutes to shoot. After a minute and 30 seconds the opponent can give a 30 second warning. If no shot is made in the next 30 seconds it is a loss of game.

CHOICE OF BALLS

- If a player makes one or more balls of the same group on the break and does not scratch, that will be his group of balls for the remainder of the game.

- If a player makes one or more of each group on the break, the table remains open until he makes another one of either group without scratching.

DISAGREEMENTS

- The two captains should settle any disputes arising during a game. Once the next game is broken there can be no disputes on an earlier game.
- If an agreement cannot be reached the game must be shot over.
- If any league member has a valid reason to protest any rule infraction he must inform the opposing team captain then inform the treasurer on the score sheet that night.

FORFEITS

- Any team with more than 16 forfeits in a season will be dropped from the league with no refund.
- Forfeits will be a win for the team and individual standings and losses for individual standings as well. Losses and wins will be given to the top four shooters on each team.
