Applicant Statement of Qualifications

In order to complete your application and be considered for an interview, you must meet the basic qualifications:

- 1. You must be at least 18 years of age.
- 2. You must have a High School diploma or equivalent (G.E.D).
- 3. You must have successfully completed Algebra I or 2 years of Introductory Algebra in High School or College or the NJATC Math course and furnish this office with an "OFFICIAL" transcript of your grades.
- 4. You must be physically and mentally able to safely perform the functions of the job.
- 5. Have cognizance of the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation requirement concerning Apprentice Electricians.

We have a five year program, training Apprentices to become Journeymen Electricians, for work in residential, commercial and industrial projects (construction work).

The five year program consists of: 2 ½ hour classes, two nights per week, 36 weeks each year for five years (providing the apprentice has satisfactory classroom grades and attendance) and completion of 8,000 hours of on-the-job.

Before the application is considered complete, the applicant must furnish a copy of their Driver's License or State ID, birth certificate and Social Security Card.

The web site will ask for the following information:

Name - (Last, First and Middle Initial)

Suffix -Examples: Jr, Sr, III

Other Names - Birth name, maiden name or alias

<u>Social Security Number</u> – This is required by section 231.302(1) of the Texas Family Code and may be disclosed to an agency authorized to assist in collection of child support payments. For more information regarding child support payments, contact the Texas Attorney General at:

Gender - "M" for male or "F" for female

Date of Birth – (MM/DD/YYYY)

<u>Telephone number</u> – Write the telephone number, including area code, where you can be reached during the day

<u>E-Mail</u> – The Department will add your e-mail address to the electrician's e-mail list which provides information from the Department on matters affecting electricians.

Mailing Address - This is the address where you will receive your license

<u>Conviction of Criminal Offense</u> – Indicate if you have been convicted of a criminal offense. If yes, complete Criminal History Questionnaire for each conviction.

<u>License Sanctions</u> – Indicate if you have ever had an occupational license suspended, revoked, probated or denied in any state, county or municipality.

Carefully read the statement at the bottom of the application before you sign and date the application. Providing false information may result in revocation of this license and the imposition of administrative penalties.
