		The auditors have confirmed that the annual audit for year ended 31 March 2019 is concluded and have provided the Annual Governance and Accountability Return.	
		Sydenham Fayre banking arrangements – OALC have confirmed that as a sub-committee the Fayre monies become part of the parish council accounts and can be notionally ringfenced for clear accounting purposes. If this is agreeable to the Fayre committee the balance will be transferred and the Fayre account closed.	
		The NALC model Financial Regulations have been updated and a new version issued in July 2019. This to be reviewed for adoption at the October meeting.	All

079		Sydenham Grove Soha are in the process of discharging the planning conditions, although there has been a delay caused by having to repeat the bat surveys. Parish councillors had a constructive meeting with Soha this week and are hoping to get an update towards the end of the year on progress.	
080		Playing Field The RoSPA inspection has been carried out, noting a few basic points to be remedied. Some of these have already been completed and the rest are in hand.	
		A replacement football goal has been purchased and installed in time for the summer holidays, hedges neatened, and tree works carried out as per the granted permission from SODC. Village opinion to be sought regarding the possible addition of adult fitness equipment.	
081		Speeding The pinch point will be installed at the end of this month, and during	
		the road closure Oxfordshire Council will also be undertaking resurfacing works along Sydenham Road up to the Inn at Emmington. The drainage investigation works by Byre House are being done within this same road closure.	

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	There has been noticeable verge erosion where the Thames Water tankers are working between the Mill House and the Stert junction. These tankers will continue twice daily until December when the road will be closed to repair the drain. The verges must be re-instated, and this issue will be taken up with Thames Water. Any verge erosion leads to wider roads and thus adds to the speeding issue. The village meeting on 23 rd July highlighted concerns on the speed of	DW
	traffic using the B4445 as well as along Sydenham Road. The Highways department have identified a suitable location for a double pinch point forming a chicane in Sydenham Road/Park View. A query arose regarding the proposed position of the pinch point nearest to Plough Corner, and so the council van was parked there as an experiment. Design drawings are to be sought for the proposed chicane, and funding options pursued.	ММ
	The parish council continue to liaise with Chinnor PC regarding speeding on the B4445 and the possibility of a pinch point near to the Emmington junction. The possibility of a 20mph zone in the centre of the village has been revisited, championed by a parishioner. The formal process for obtaining this to be researched and advice sought from the County Councillor and from Askett parish who undertook a similar project. The lack of visible junction warning and 30mph signs on the B4445 has	AI
	been reported to Highways and Thames Valley Police.	HM/AI
082	Neighbourhood Plan The formal consultation finishes on 5 th September. SODC have gone to tender for the Inspector who will examine the plan and provided a list of candidates. The parish council agreed that Mr A. Ashcroft should be appointed.	НМ

084	Parish footpath review A completed Rights of Way Unresolved Issue form to be submitted. The review shows that many stiles need replacing. It may be possible to obtain funding for replacing some with gates to improve accessibility. Village opinion to be sought via survey, and feedback obtained as to which paths are most frequently used.
