MINUTES: May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019

Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. called to order the Village of Bloomingburg Regular Board of Trustees Meeting on May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 6:00pm in the Village of Bloomingburg Hall, Bloomingburg, N.Y.

The meeting was open with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Regular Meeting**

Mayor Wood asked the Board if they had a chance to review the minutes from April.

Trustee Aaron Rabiner & Samuel Weingarten both agreed they have.

Mayor Wood asks for a motion to approve April's bills. Trustee Samuel Weingarten makes the motion and is seconded by Trustee Aaron Rabiner.

Mayor Wood asks Trustee's if they had a chance to review the minutes from last month's meeting.

Trustee Samuel Weingarten and Trustee Aaron Rabiner both agree they have.

Mayor Wood asks for a motion to approve the minutes from April. Trustee Samuel Weingarten makes the motion and is seconded by Trustee Aaron Rabiner.

Mayor Wood: We have a proposal from Frontier about installing a new phone system. There will be 3 phones. There will be capability to transfer calls from the court, building inspector and the Village Clerk desk. There will be prompts for what department you would like. They will need to upgrade the internet for the Village. This will only cost the Village an extra \$60.00 a month but it is something we need to have.

Samuel Weingarten: I was here when they came with the proposal and they explained it to me and I agree with the proposal.

Aaron Rabiner: I do as well.

Mayor Wood: ok, with that I would like a motion to approve the proposal.

Aaron Rabiner: I'll make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I'll second it.

Mayor Wood: We have spoken about the water proposal for a few months now. I would like a motion to hire Lanc and Tully and sign the agreement with them so we can move forward.

Aaron Rabiner: I'll make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I'll second it.

Mayor Wood: I would like to open the public hearing for Local Law #4 of 2019 – Mandatory construction of sidewalks in the Village.

Aaron Rabiner: I will make the motion.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second it.

Mayor Wood: Explains the Local Law will be for any new construction in the Village, you will be required to put in a sidewalk in the front of the property.

Alex Smith- Reads the law

Mayor Wood: can I have a motion to close the public hearing.

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I second it.

Mayor Wood: Any comment? Can I have a motion to pass this local law?

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I second it.

Mayor Wood: We need to approve Sexual Harassment Training for Village appointments & employees. It will take place online and the cost is \$30.00 per member of the Village.

Aaron Rabiner: I approve the online training.

Samuel Weingarten: I approve it as well.

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to open the public hearing for the Village budget for 2019/2020.

Samuel Weingarten: I will make the motion

Aaron Weingarten: I second the motion.

Mayor Wood: I produced a copy last month of the proposed budget. Any questions? Can I have a motion to close the hearing?

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I second it.

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to approve the budget for 2019/2020?

Samuel Weingarten: I will make it.

Aaron Rabiner: I second it.

Mayor Wood: Next is the continuation of 6 Old Roosa Gap Road, I have excused myself from this.

Aaron Rabiner: I will make a motion to reopen the public hearing.

Gloria Finley: Why? What is going there? Why do they want to change from R1 to NBD? It's a residential area. Why? I would like to know. I live across the street. I have the right to know what he would like to go there. Why isn't he here? This is spot zoning.

Alex Smith: No it is not. 97 Godfrey Road is NBD the lots are next to each other. The applicant doesn't have to provide this board the reason why he wants to change the zoning. The Planning Board takes the project into consideration. This board only grants or denies the request.

Aaron Rabiner: Ok can I have a motion to close the public hearing?

Samuel Weingarten: I will make it.

Aaron Rabiner: Samuel are you ready to vote on this?

Samuel Weingarten: No I am not. She has valid questions.

Aaron Rabiner: ok. No vote tonight. We will hold it and vote next month.

Mayor Wood: Can I have a motion to close this evenings meeting?

Aaron Rabiner: I will make it.

Samuel Weingarten: I will second it.

Mayor Wood: All in favor; Aye.
