

Samuel F. Henne passed away Sunday, Sept. 24, 1972, at Heritage Nursing Home after a long illness. Age 84 years. He was born Jan. 19, 1888, in Bay Port. He resided in Saginaw most of his life. He married Gertrude Eib in Saginaw May 3, 1924. She survives him.

He was employed by the Pere Marquette Railway from Sept. 28, 1909, until Sept. 7, 1918. In 1918, he founded the Henne Moving and Storage Co. which he operated until his illness. His son, Bryce joined him in 1941, and his son David joined them in 1953. He was an ardent hunter.
