NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all interested persons in Cooke, Collin and Denton Counties, Texas:

That the Board of Directors of the North Texas Groundwater Conservation District (“District”) will hold a public hearing to discuss, consider, receive public comments, and potentially act upon adoption of the District Management Plan.

The public hearing will be held on Tuesday, August 9, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. at the Pilot Point Independent School District Administration office, located at 829 S. Harrison Street, Pilot Point, Texas 76258. Comments on the proposed Management Plan may be presented in written or verbal form at the hearing, and persons interested in submitting written comments in advance may do so by sending comments to the District at P.O. Box 508, Gainesville, Texas 76241 or by email at ntgcd@northtexasgcd.org. Any person who desires to appear at the hearing and present comments may do so in person, by legal representative, or both. The hearing posted in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate. At the conclusion of the hearing or any time or date thereafter, the proposed Management Plan may be adopted in the form presented or as amended based upon comments received from the public, District staff, consultants, or members of the Board without any additional notice.

A copy of the proposed Management Plan will be available not less than 20 days before the date of the hearing by requesting a copy by email to ntgcd@northtexasgcd.org, by accessing the District’s website at www.northtexasgcd.org, or by reviewing or copying the proposed Management Plan in person at 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, Texas 75020.
