

I made a brief, initial excursion back to St. Cecilia's last weekend to participate in a Reconciliation Retreat we had initially planned with families of our First Communion candidates in mid-January. That earlier event was canceled due to a snow emergency and rescheduled for last weekend as our last opportunity to complete this before our kids could shift focus on their final preparation to join us at the eucharistic table. I'm grateful that Archbishop Hebda was free to join us last weekend to help us focus this Lenten season as a time of preparation and welcome for these candidates. The weekend's experience was powerful for me as I was touched by the tender care of our parents and catechists for our young people. The simplicity and earnestness of our young ones and their parents as they entered into our prayer time during the retreat was deeply moving.

I was also able to receive the many expressions of care and support that so many of you sent to the parish office. I took a bag full of cards and notes home and spent the afternoon opening and savoring the greetings you sent. Most dear to me were messages from our youngest members. One of our youngsters expressed the hope that my knee gets better and then reported "other people are wondering about you." Hm. Another hoped I could come back "and give all of us normal Sunday Church."

I'm hoping this week to review the path ahead with my surgeon as I prepare to make a shift from my predominantly homebound status. In the coming week I will be coming in for interviews with candidates for our Parish Operations position and for some parish meetings with staff, Finance Committee and Parish Community Council. My first weekend back for some of the weekend liturgies will be March 14/15. All of this depends on the cooperation of Mother Nature.

I'm grateful to all of my priest colleagues who've filled in and to Marge Virnig for arranging their scheduling. Our many liturgical ministers helped keep things moving. While we look forward to the celebrations ahead of the Triduum and Easter, we will also need to consider adjustments we may need to make due to the virus that threatens our communities.


