DNR Direct & Immediate Orders May 6, 2014

- Cease pumping of waste to the ground
- Immediate haul and spread manure safely to available fields
- County provided list of possible other storage facilities in the area
- County reviewed current nutrient management plan and available fields
- Landowner contacted excavator to mobilize equipment

Field Notes

- Landowners verify that they last hauled manure to field sometime in late summer of 2013.
- CPZ estimates that approximately 1,000,000 gallons of waste was discharged.
- Landowners no longer owns, controls, or rents any of the adjacent cropland. 240 acres sold in 2010.
