Pool Rules

1. The pool is only open when Lifeguards are on duty. The pool will be closed on Mondays for cleaning.
2. All residents and guest must sign in with the Lifeguard.
3. Only people with proper identification (Pool Tags) will be admitted. Only three (3) guests are allowed per card. Guest(s) must be accompanied by a resident at ALL times.
4. Persons under the age of 14 must not be in the pool without adult supervision. The responsible adult MUST remain with the minor children at all times.
5. Only children six (6) years and under may use the wading pool.
6. Only proper swimming attire will be allowed in the pool. No cut-off clothing will be allowed. Babies MUST wear plastic pants over diapers.
7. All persons must shower before entering the pool.
8. Persons with open cuts and sores are not allowed in the pool.
9. Glass items are not allowed in the pool yard.
10. No alcoholic beverages, no tobacco products and no weapons or illegal substances of any kind are allowed in the pool area.
11. Floats and tubes are NOT allowed. Child safety floats ONLY.
12. No diving, horse play, running or profanity allowed in the pool area.
13. Pets in the pool are prohibited.
14. No tampering with pool equipment.
15. No littering. Please clean up your own trash.
16. No radios are allowed in the pool area.
17. The pool company hired by the association is the only authorized provider of swimming lessons.
18. The Lifeguards have full authority to enforce all pool rules
19. Failure to comply with these rules may result in expulsion from the pool and having your pool privileges suspended.
20. Only Lifeguards are allowed in the guard room and pump room.
21. Lifeguards will tell violators of the rules to leave the pool area.
22. Law enforcement will be called on unruly behavior.
23. Do NOT swim if you have been ill with diarrhea within the past 2 weeks.
24. Changing diapers within 6 feet of pool is prohibited.
25. Extended breath holding activities are dangerous and prohibited.
