Stewart Muir is the Director of Living Collections for the Whitley Wildlife Conservation Trust which includes Paignton Zoo, Newquay Zoo and Living Coasts in the South West of England. He is also founder and Honorary Director of Shaldon Wildlife Trust in Devon. Stewart was, for 10 years, the Small Carnivore Taxonomic Advisory Group Chairman for EAZA (European Association of Zoos and Aquaria). For many years he has been a supporter and advisor to the Carnivore and Pangolin Conservation Program (CPCP) based in Cuc Phuong National Park in Vietnam. Originally the project started based around the conservation programme for the Owston's civet and has been growing ever since. He is still advisor to the Owston's civet conservation breeding programme within Europe. Stewart is also an advisor to the newly-formed NGO Save Vietnam's Wildlife.
