


DEFINITION OF IMPERIALISM

AND WORK ANOTHER'S GAIN.





CARTOON WHERE THE TERM "YELLOW JOURNALISM" CAME FROM

IN 1898 NEWSPAPERS PROVIDED THE PUBLIC WITH INFORMATION. PEOPLE LACKED THE ABILITY TO VERIFY IF THE STORIES WERE BIASED OR **INACCURATE AND THEREFORE RELIED UPON NEWSPAPERS TO TELL** THE TRUTH. PULITZER AND HEARST **TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THE PUBLIC'S IGNORANCE BY TWISTING THE TRUTH** TO SELL MORE NEWSPAPERS. SENSATIONALIZED STORIES WERE FEATURED HEAVILY IN THEIR **NEWSPAPERS SINCE EXCITING** HEADLINES INCREASED **CIRCULATION.**


THE U.S. PUBLIC WAS ESPECIALLY SYMPATHETIC TOWARDS WOMEN IN CUBA. HEARST FOCUSED ON A YOUNG WOMAN, KNOWN IN THE **UNITED STATES AS EVANGELINA CISNEROS, WHO WAS IMPRISONED** IN HAVANA. PETITIONS FOR HER **FREEDOM WERE SIGNED BY PROMINENT U.S. WOMEN AND THE** POPE, AND ADDRESSED TO THE QUEEN REGENT OF SPAIN. **EVANGELINA MANAGED TO ESCAPE WITH THE HELP OF CORRESPONDENT KARL DECKER,** WHO PROBABLY BRIBED HER **GUARDS. THE STORY PRESENTED** TO THE PUBLIC WAS THAT OF A **HEROIC "JOURNALIST THAT** ACTS.^{II}



TELLER AMENDMENT, 1898


RESOLVED, FIRST. THAT THE PEOPLE OF THE ISLAND OF CUBA... OUGHT TO BE FREE AND INDEPENDENT.

SECOND. IT IS THE DUTY OF THE UNITED STATES TO DEMAND THAT SPAIN RELINQUISH ITS AUTHORITY OF CUBA AND WITHDRAW ITS LAND AND NAVAL FORCES FROM CUBA.

THIRD. THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES IS DIRECTED TO USE THE FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES TO CARRY THESE RESOLUTIONS INTO EFFECT.

FOURTH. THE UNITED STATES DISCLAIMS ANY INTENTION TO EXERCISE CONTROL OVER SAID ISLAND, AND ASSERTS WHEN THAT IS ACCOMPLISHED, TO LEAVE THE GOVERNMENT AND CONTROL OF THE ISLAND TO ITS PEOPLE.




ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF IMPERIALISM IN THE PHILIPPINES




... Just beyond the Philippines are China's illimitable markets... The Philippines gives us a base at the East... They [the Filipinos] are a barbarous race ... It is barely possible that 1,000 men in all the [Philippines] are capable of self-government in the Anglo-Saxon sense... <u>The Declaration [of Independence] applies only to</u> <u>people capable of self-government</u>.

And you, who say the Declaration applies to all men, how dare you deny its application to the American Indian? And if you deny it to the Indian at home, how dare you grant it to the [Filipinos] abroad.




























DOLLAR DIPLOMACY



PRESIDENT WILLIAM HOWARD TAFT

"THE DIPLOMACY OF THE PRESENT ADMINISTRATION HAS SOUGHT TO RESPOND TO MODERN IDEAS OF COMMERCIAL INTERCOURSE. THIS POLICY HAS BEEN CHARACTERIZED AS SUBSTITUTING DOLLARS FOR **BULLETS. IT IS ONE THAT APPEALS ALIKE TO IDEALISTIC HUMANITARIAN** SENTIMENTS, TO THE DICTATES OF SOUND POLICY AND STRATEGY, AND TO LEGITIMATE COMMERCIAL AIMS. IT IS AN EFFORT FRANKLY DIRECTED TO THE INCREASE OF AMERICAN TRADE **UPON THE AXIOMATIC PRINCIPLE** THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF THE **UNITED STATES SHALL EXTEND ALL PROPER SUPPORT TO EVERY** LEGITIMATE AND BENEFICIAL **AMERICAN ENTERPRISE ABROAD.**" **TAFT**, 1912

PRESIDENT WOODROW WILSON

THERE HAS BEEN SOMETHING CRUDE AND HEARTLESS AND UNFEELING IN OUR HASTE TO SUCCEED AND BE GREAT. OUR THOUGHT HAS BEEN "LET EVERY MAN LOOK OUT FOR HIMSELF, LET EVERY GENERATION LOOK **OUT FOR ITSELF, "WHILE WE REARED GIANT** MACHINERY WHICH MADE IT IMPOSSIBLE THAT ANY BUT THOSE WHO STOOD AT THE LEVERS OF CONTROL SHOULD HAVE A CHANCE TO LOOK OUT FOR THEMSELVES. WE HAD NOT FORGOTTEN OUR MORALS. WE **REMEMBERED WELL ENOUGH THAT WE HAD** SET UP A POLICY WHICH WAS MEANT TO SERVE THE HUMBLEST AS WELL AS THE MOST POWERFUL, WITH AN EYE SINGLE TO THE STANDARDS OF JUSTICE AND FAIR PLAY, AND REMEMBERED IT WITH PRIDE. BUT WE WERE VERY HEEDLESS AND IN A HURRY TO **BE GREAT.**
