

# American Bar Association appoints Memphis Attorney

Incoming ABA President Paulette Brown has appointed Memphis Attorney Florence M Johnson to the Commission on *Racial and Ethnic Diversity in the Profession* for the 2015-2016 term. This is the third Presidential Appointment for Johnson previously having been selected to the *Special Committee for Disaster Response Preparedness* in 2009 and 2010. Atty Johnson is honored to be appointed to this position by Paulette Brown, the first African American female president of the ABA.
