High school students in the Tampa area benefit from a nationwide program designed to introduce them to the wide range of career opportunities open to young people in Architecture, Construction, Engineering, and related areas of the building design and construction industry.

At weekly meetings, student teams work directly with professionals from area firms, who volunteer their time to mentor the teams as they design hypothetical projects, tour local construction sites, and visit architectural, engineering and construction offices.
