As a result he became a street child.

I don't remember how he made it to adulthood but he was a hard worker who provided the best he could on a fry cook's salary. As kids, my brothers and I wished for the things that many other kids had, and one of those things was a bicycle.

Knowing this, a kind neighbor gave me a bike that was mostly worn out, but to me it was the most beautiful thing I ever had. As soon as I could get the tires to hold air, I was ready to give it a test run, but no! My mother called me into the house and asked, "Do you think you deserve that bike?"

"Well, yeah," I answered.

"I don't think so," she said. "Sit on that chair until you figure out why you don't!"

All that I could think of was all the things I'd done that she didn't know about, and each time I gave her a reason, she kept saying that I hadn't figured it out yet. That was one of the longest days of my life.

It finally came to me. I had not thanked my neighbor for the bike. Being thankful was a really big deal in our family. My mom and dad couldn't provide stuff, but they made a big deal about giving us character.
