Now, we stand just days away, reflecting in awe of all He has done in preparation for this walk. I am thrilled beyond measure and honored to serve as lay director of walk 167. I am simply one member of the team that God will use this next weekend. Each one that is involved is important. We are all here for one purpose. That clarion call is to love Him with all of our heart and to make His love known to each other and to these pilgrims. Please continue to pray and allow His love to be shed abroad in each of our hearts.




