Sunday's Reflection

The passage we have just heard is pivotal in the Gospels.
Everything that precedes this passage prepares us for it;
everything that follows it is an explanation.

Jesus asks his closest followers a fundamental question:
"Who do you say I am?" Peter speaks for the apostles:
"You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God!" They
acknowledge that Jesus is the promised Messiah; he is the
very Son of God.

This is a true moment of faith, proclaimed for the ages.
Jesus makes it very clear that they are responding with the
gift given to them by his heavenly Father, not just to the
mere sum of their own experiences of Jesus. This becomes
clearer as the Gospel progresses, and we see that they
have much more to learn about how Jesus will be the
Messiah-Savior.


At this point in the Gospel narrative, they have no idea that Jesus will suffer, die on a cross, and rise on the third day. Despite their lack of full understanding, Jesus uses this moment of faith to set the foundation of the Church on the "rock" of Peter's confession of faith. He entrusts the keys of the kingdom to Peter: the symbol of authority in the community of believers. The Church will have power to continue when Jesus returns to his Father.

For the moment, Jesus orders his disciples not to tell anyone that he is the Messiah because they have much more to learn before they can accurately communicate the full truth of faith in Jesus as Messiah. Once they have experienced Jesus' death and resurrection and have received the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit, Jesus will tell them to go out to all the nations and proclaim the Good News of salvation.

We heard St. Paul sum up the wonder of God's plan of salvation, meant for all people. His words are a reminder that we are part of the continuing plan as members of the community founded on the authority of Peter. As we continue to grow in our knowledge and experience of the good news, we can well echo Paul's words: "O, the depths of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God!"

As we speak his words, let us be grateful for the gift of faith and renew our commitment to live by what we have come to believe - so that all we are and do is seen as coming from God, done through his grace, and leading us to give God glory today and every day!

Reflexión Semanal

Perspectiva Salesiana

"Qué grandiosas son las riquezas y la sabiduría y el conocimiento de Dios!"

En su Tratado del Amor de Dios, San Francisco de Sales escribió: "Como podemos ver el universo, y especialmente la naturaleza humana, es como un reloj compuesto de una variedad tan grande de acciones y movimientos que no podemos contener nuestra admiración por él. Todos sabemos que en general cada una de estas partes, que han sido creadas de formas tan diferentes, todas sirven para desplegar, como en el interior de un reloj, la justicia sagrada de Dios, o para manifestar el triunfo de la misericordia y la bondad de Dios, como en un canto de alabanza. Pero entender individualmente la función de cada una de las partes, ya sea para entender su función en general o el por qué están hechas de tal forma, no es posible a manos que no entendamos lo que el relojero supremo nos enseña. Dios no nos revela su arte para que podamos admirarlo con gran reverencia hasta que lleguemos al cielo, donde Dios nos abrumara con la belleza de su sabiduría. Entonces, en la abundancia de su amor Dios nos revelara las razones, los significados y los motivos para todo lo que ha

sucedido en este mundo para asegurar nuestra salvación eterna". (Libro IV, Capítulo 8)

¿Quién puede llegar a entender la mente de Dios? ¿Quién de nosotros puede aspirar a entender el plan que Dios ha diseñado para nosotros? ¿Quién de nosotros puede comprender el alcance y la profundidad del amor que Dios siente por nosotros? La justicia de Dios se extiende más allá de los límites de la mente humana.

Aun cuando no entendemos la mente de Dios, podemos llegar a conocer claramente el corazón de Dios... a través de la persona de su hijo y nuestro salvador, Jesucristo.

En Cristo podemos ver al Dios que nos ha creado. En Cristo podremos ver al Dios que nos ha redimido. En Cristo podemos ver al Dios que nos ha inspirado. En Cristo podemos ver al Dios que nos ama, nos perdona, nos reta, que se preocupa por nosotros y que anhela nuestra felicidad.

En Cristo también podemos ver algo más: lo que significa ser completamente humano. La mente humana y el corazón humano están en su mejor disposición cuando son compasivos, cuando perdonan, cuando son honestos, cuando son pacíficos y generosos. En Cristo, el humilde y gentil sirviente, podemos ver lo que significa ser verdaderamente humano, lo que significa ser hijos e hijas del Dios viviente.

Hay muchas cosas sobre la mentalidad de Dios que solo podemos aspirar a entender y conocer en el cielo. Pero mientras eso sucede, la sumatoria de nuestros esfuerzos debe ser dirigida al entendimiento y la personificación del corazón de Dios en nuestras relaciones con los demás aquí en la tierra.

"Qué tan profundos son las riquezas, la sabiduría y el conocimiento de Dios" en todos y cada uno de nosotros. ¿Cómo podemos compartir estas riquezas y esta sabiduría con los demás hoy, y como podemos llegar a reconocer en nosotros características del corazón de Dios?
