With over a hundred people in attendance, we had a beautiful celebration this past Wednesday Evening to mark the 100th anniversary of the 5th appearance of the Blessed Virgin Mary to the children in Fatima, Portugal. Our Lady provided us with gorgeous weather. During the potluck supper at the picnic area, it was nearly impossible to avoid being stung by a yellow jacket, but up on the hilltop, by the Marian Shrine, where we had the Eucharistic Procession and Rosary, there wasn't a nasty bug to be found. I guess the blessed Mother wasn't about to have any pesky insects interfering with the adoration of her son. As we prayed, a gentle breeze blew through the trees and golden leaves dropped down from the heavens. If you haven't yet made it to one of these events, you have one more chance. 
