Both Twin Cities and Sierra Vista have achieved consecutive A's every reporting period since the ratings first came out in 2012. They are 2 of only 41 hospitals nation-wide that have achieved this straight A record.

### ROUNABOUT AT 46W AND VINEYARD DRIVE ON TAAG AGENDA - INSTALLATION CHARACTERIZED AS "IMMINENT"

The Templeton Area Advisory Group (TAAG) will hear a report on Thursday night from Caltrans on the "status and imminent installation" of a roundabout to replace the four-way stop at the intersection of 46W and Vineyard Drive.

The agenda also includes a lot line adjustment at 400 Crum Road, a proposed permit to hold up to 20 events per year at 4015 Almond Drive, and a commercial mixed-use project at 221 N. Main Street.

### SUPERVISORS PASS BUDGET AND HOMELESS ITEM 14 BUT ARE STILL WORKING ON HEMP AND PASO BASIN QUESTIONS

**HEMP**-Despite a significant push by a newspaper ad campaign to bring in a significant number of pro hemp speakers, the Board of Supervisors voted 4-1 (Gibson NO) Tuesday for a "time out" on growing industrial hemp in San Luis Obispo County. The Supervisors voting in favor of the moratorium cited a number of questions and concerns they felt needed to be answered before any more permits were issued. Those already holding permits to grow hemp will be able to move forward - including a large grow just outside the town of Templeton near the junction of Templeton Road, El Pomar and

Moss Lane.


**PASO BASIN** - While a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the Paso Basin is nearing completion and adoption, County staff believes there would be as much as a five year gap between development and implementation of the plan - leaving the basin without any significant oversight. The Board of Supervisors directed staff to look into some unforeseen consequences incurred by smaller agriculture and rural residential users thru the original water offset programs the County adopted for the Paso Basin. Staff will be bringing the necessary information and amendments back to the Board in two phases with a hard deadline in November to either adopt an extension of the program or not.
