"Having such a fond affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our very own lives, because you had become so very dear to us." (NASB)

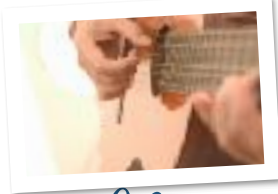

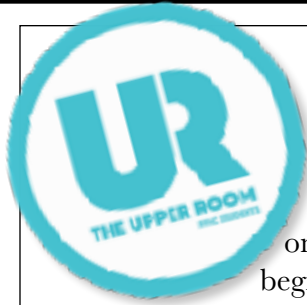
