Release and Indemnification

As a parent or guardian of the participant in the Coal Creek Midget Football League, Inc. program, I understand that football is a rough and competitive contact sport. In consideration of my child being allowed to participate, I expressly agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Lafayette Bobcat Football organization and the Coal Creek Midget Football League, it's board of directors, coaches, agents, officials, BVSD, and the City of Lafayette from any and all claims, demands or actions that may arise as a result of any injury my child receives while being transported to or from, or participation in the Coal Creek Midget Football League. Provided, however, this release and promise of indemnification shall not extend to any claim, demand or action for which there is insurance coverage in effect. I authorize the coaches or league officials to obtain medical attention for my child in case of an emergency. I release them from responsibility in connection with such medical attention. I will provide a copy of my child's birth certificate, if so requested. I give my permission and consent to the use of any photographs, videotapes, or other media record of my child's participation in the Lafayette Bobcat Football league for any lawful purpose, without compensation to me or on my behalf. I understand that such image(s) may appear in a publication, printed matter, media release, website or other form of promotion. If I do not want my child to be photographed, videotaped, or in other recorded media, it is my responsibility to inform the Lafayette Bobcat Football league in writing.

2018 Fee Disclosure, Uniform Deposit, Scholarship and Refund Policy

General Registration

The registration fee is to be **paid in FULL** prior to the first game. A player is ineligible* to play until the registration fee is paid in full.

Uniforms

The **Uniform Deposit** (in the form of a \$250 check) is due at the time a uniform is issued to a player. NO equipment/uniform will be issued until this check is issued to LBF. This check will be held until which time the **equipment and clean uniform is returned** to LBF. Uniform deposits will be processed (cashed) on the **next business day** after the scheduled uniform and equipment turn-in date. If the participant's uniform and equipment is turned in **after** the scheduled turn-in date, a **\$50 Late Fee** will be processed from the participant's deposit check. The remaining balance will be returned within 30 days to the address on file for said participant.

If all equipment issued to the player is returned by the published return date, NO additional fees are imposed.

Scholarships

Partial scholarships may be offered to families based on their financial need. A **Scholarship Application** must be completed for a confidential review by the LBF Scholarship Committee (which consists of the Board President, Vice President, and Treasurer).

The Uniform Deposit and Equipment Fee Agreement is still the responsibility of the participant, even if a partial scholarship is awarded. The player will be ineligible* until the registration fee (pending scholarship allowance) is paid in full and the Equipment Fee Agreement is signed. Considerations for scholarship are dependent on applicants committing their time to volunteer for the various needs of the LBF throughout the season.

Families requesting scholarships can download the Scholarship Application form from the LBF website, or can contact an LBF Board Member directly for a copy.

Refunds

- A 50% refund will be issued to any player who chooses to not participate in the LBF **prior to the First game** of the season (BEFORE 8/25/18).
- NO refunds will be issued **after the FIRST game** of the season (on/after 8/25/18).

**Ineligible: The participant is not allowed to participate in any LBF activity including practices and games.*

Code of Conduct

PARENT / GUARDIAN Agreement and Code of Conduct

I (We) understand that:

- Lafayette Bobcat Football (LBF) is a non-profit, volunteer organization for competitive youth football and a member of the Coal Creek Midget Football League.
- The coaching staff and players are expected to abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the CCMFL and LBF.
- The LBF coaching staff for each division will set their own practice schedule, team rules and policies in accordance with LBF guidelines to put competitive teams on the field.
- While in attendance of a LBF/CCMFL sponsored function, we are expected to conduct ourselves in a manner so that our actions may not be deemed unacceptable by the game official(s), coaches, players, opposing team or any CCMFL representatives in attendance.

The following may result:

- 1) Penalty resulting in loss of yardage
- 2) Ejection of player(s) or coach(s)
- 3) Ejection of parent(s)
- 4) Forfeiture of game
- 5) Police intervention

LBF reserves the right to:

- 1) Review these situations and take the necessary steps to prevent future occurrences
- 2) Ensure the player's safety
- 3) Ensure players are not exposed to fan misconduct
- 4) Ensure the team is not penalized due to fan misconduct

I (We) will:

- Do my best to get my player to practice and games on time.
- Encourage good sportsmanship by always demonstrating POSITIVE support for all players, coaches, opponents, and officials.
- Respect the coaching staff by NOT coaching your child during practices or games. I will limit my comments to encouragement for the players.
- Respect and support the coaching staff's decisions.



- Respect the team’s practice space and be aware of the designated team boundaries at games and not encroach upon these areas.
- Refrain from making negative comments about the coaching staff in my player’s presence.
- I will request a conversation or meeting with the coach to discuss the situation if I have a problem with a coach. If not resolved, I will submit a written complaint to the LBF President for review.
- I WILL NOT approach the coaching staff DURING OR AFTER A GAME to discuss a complaint or concern. I will follow the LBF policy of waiting 24 hours before expressing concerns or complaints with a coach following a game. *EXCEPTION: If a safety matter arises, parent(s) may approach the coaching staff in a confidential conversation in order to raise the coach’s awareness. The coach will take that input and work directly with the referee staff as appropriate. Parents should not shout across the field or engage the referees under any circumstance.*
- If I exhibit improper conduct during any practice, scrimmage, or game, I will be asked to leave the field, may be fined or suspended in accordance to LBF Bylaws and CCMFL Rules and Regulations.

PLAYER Agreement and Code of Conduct

I will:

- Be ON TIME to practices and games. **Attendance is mandatory.** Excused absences include: sickness, school obligations and other commitments deemed reasonable. Notify my coach at least 1 hour prior to practice or game if requesting an absence. In the event I cannot reach my coach, I will notify my Team Parent.
- Bring water to every practice.
- Not wear game jersey or game pants to practice. Game jerseys may be worn ONLY on game day, to school on Fridays before a game (Maroon jersey ONLY), or a Bobcat sponsored function. When I wear my Bobcat jersey I understand that I represent the LBF organization and will act in an appropriate manner.
- Wear my mouth guard for every play in practice and games (not doing so will result in a penalty in a game). Wear my protective cup in accordance with CCMFL rules.
- Stay within the designated player area during games. Pay attention during entire duration of games.
- Control my emotions and display good sportsmanship to my teammates and the opposing players. *No cussing or mouthing off to ANY of the coaches, teammates, or opposing players.
*No throwing equipment *Always be positive towards teammates and coaches
- Respect the game officials at all times. Worrying over a play call will only distract you from playing your best. Let the coaching staff handle these issues.

Your true strength of character and leadership will be displayed on the field of play when you are under pressure.
