

HOW TO USE THE VILLAGE COORDINATES.

The coordinates match the entrance to the villages houses - not the houses.
You can put the coordinates into your GPS (SatNav) or Google Maps
Remember to put 'N' for the Latitude and 'W' for the Longitude

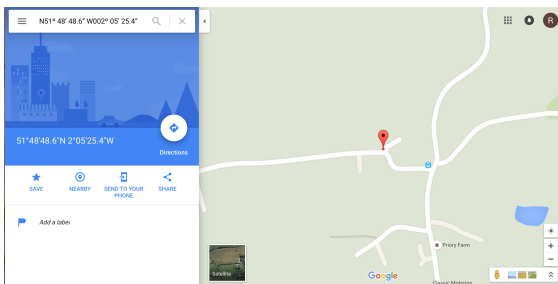
Google Maps can use, but don't normally use, Longitude or Latitude and your GPS may not be set up to use it either. It will use a Digital coordinate format where W is a negative figure. There are free phone apps to convert Longitude & Latitude to Digital. Otherwise, you can right click on your house or house entrance position in Google Maps and then click on 'What's Here.' You'll then get the Digital equivalent.

For example:

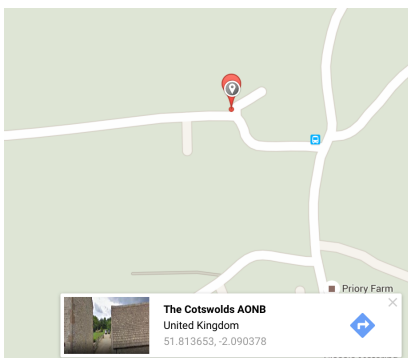
The Village Hall entrance coordinates are:

N51° 48' 48.6" W002° 05' 25.4"

If you call for this on Google Maps you get:



It's spot on. But if you right click on the red dot and then click on 'What's here' you get



It's still spot on but identifies the Digital coordinates of 51.813653, -2.090378

My recommendation is send both Longitude & Latitude and Digital formats to your couriers to avoid any confusion. Many of the sites you buy from have a section where you can put in delivery instructions. You can put the coordinates in there. Most couriers use their GPS to get to Brimpsfield, often using the Post Code. The Post Code isn't accurate enough but if they can use the coordinates, this will get them within 3m of your house entrance.
