### ZONING:

Inspector Marshall reported 1 permit and 1 variance for the month and YTD. The permit was for a Ron Hedges on Hopewell Church Road for an accessory building and the variance is for Travis Cupp for a lot split on Crumley Road.

### CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE FISCAL OFFICER:

Minutes from the February Meeting being read prior by the Board were approved as read, so moved by Trustee Wolfe and seconded by Trustee Shaw. All were in favor with 3 ayes and no negative votes, motion passed. Fiscal Officer Ressler asked for a resolution to move from temporary appropriations to permanent appropriations for FY20. Trustee Wolfe so moved and

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seconded by Trustee Shaw. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Shaw– Yes, Wolfe - Yes. Motion approved.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT:**

Fire Department reported monthly runs so far have been 17 fire and 39 EMS for a total of 110 runs YTD. Mutual aid was provided to Amanda, Berne, Greenfield, and Lancaster. A total of 10 runs to SCI. the new hose from grant is in service. The truck grant was submitted Monday and will wait 4-8 months for the result. A fire marshal grant was submitted for outdated equipment and gear. ODNR grant was received for a new UTV. The fire department will need to look at additional space requirements for equipment and hose.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

1. The county will keep Hocking Township informed as to the progress of the OPWC on Meister Road.
2. Hamburg Road property with the criminal mischief and the junk cars are still being looked into.
3. Hocking Township will continue to monitor Stonewall Cemetery Road and Stepath Mound Lane for erosion.
4. Health Department meeting was January 30, 2020 at 7:00pm in the commissioners hearing room.
5. Update on Intelliwave – Nathan will start on 16<sup>th</sup> Road as the next project. He needs residents to sign up to show interest on their roads.
6. ODOT is holding a public meeting on March 11, 2020 at 7:00pm in the Fairfield County Engineers Office about Route 22 and 159 and Route 22 and Delmont Road.
7. Hocking Township received an email about Route 188 an Becks Knob Road and ODOT don't have no planned crash countermeasure improvements at this time for that intersection.
8. Census paperwork has been certified and sent back.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**


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
1. A proposed Loves Gas Station is in the design/location phase for being located at Route 188 and Delmont Road.

There being no further business to discuss Trustee Shaw motioned to adjourn and Trustee Wolfe seconded the motion.




