There are times in our lives when we can boast about an accomplishment. Someone winning the gold medal at the Olympics certainly would qualify. Someone winning a Nobel Peace Prize could boast about their accomplishments. Most of us understand and recognize the significance of those events, and happily sit and listen to the stories. However, a sense of humility must also prevail over our accomplishments even ones as great as the Olympics or Nobel.

This week Paul tries to reach the Corinthians again with his message of salvation. He begins with boasting about an event that occurred in his life. But he knows that they will not be impressed with that, so he concludes with the thorn in his life that keeps him grounded.

Paul tells us in Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Paul uses that mantra to prove how the grace of God, despite our highs or lows, suffices in allowing us the gift of salvation.

So whether high or low, we need not boast or complain, but rely on the grace of God to see us through.




