



2017 Okaloosa/Walton Homeless Veteran Stand Down Statistics



- We served 123 Veterans and 58 Non-Vets, 181 total. 147 male/34 female. (2016 statistics reflected 117 Veterans and 54 Non-Vets served, 171 total)
- 51 volunteers helped on set-up day (Nov 2nd)
- 237 volunteers/staff assisted on event day (Nov 3rd). *Note- 299 were scheduled to assist/attend.
- 135 HMIS surveys collected.
- 33 attended Vet Court
- 10 applied for food stamps
- 31 received haircuts
- 59 signed for bikes
- 34 received service from the County VSO
- 101 visited VA HUDVASH table
- 0 visited VA Mental Health or Suicide Prevention. *Note – Room allocated for them was not manned. Sat at HUDVASH table.
- 137 received MHA ditty bags. 102 were Vets, 35 were Non-Vets.
- 33 received dental examinations from Dr. Woo
- 23 received dental examinations from PanCare
- 15 received medical examinations from PanCare
- 14 received VA administered immunizations/ 0 Medical screenings
- 18 visited 90Works
- 128 visited Career Source

- 97 received VA surplus clothing/boots
- 7 visited HIV screening
- 2 received Non-VA mental health screenings
- 92 visited the Vet Center
- 30 dogs received services from the Veterinarian
- 370 Clients/Volunteers/Staff were fed. Thank you to the FWB and Niceville American Legions and the Ladies Auxiliary!
- 300 Emerald Coast Transit bus passes issued to 9 Veteran Service Organizations and several clients

Note – VA Registration from the Eglin CBOC was a No-show for the event. No veteran services were provided from this office.
