ETIQUETTE; BEHAVIOR ON THE COURSE

SCGA Guidelines on the manner in which the game of golf should be played. If they are followed all players will gain maximum enjoyment from the game. The overriding principle is that consideration should be shown to others on the course at all times.

The spirit of the game

Golf is played for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

Safety

Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the ball, or any stones, pebbles, twigs, or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing. Players should not play until the players in front are out of range. If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is danger of hitting someone, he should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such situations is "FORE"

Pace of play

Play at a good pace and keep up

Be ready to play

Players should be ready to play as soon as it is their turn to play. When playing on or near the putting green, they should leave their bags or carts in such a position as will enable quick movement off the green and towards the next tee.

Lost Ball

If a player believes his ball may be lost outside a water hazard or is out of bounds, to save time, he should hit a provisional ball.

Care of the Course

Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully fill up and smooth over all holes and footprints made by them and any nearby made by others. If a rake is within reasonable proximately of the bunker, the rake should be used for this purpose.

Repairs of Divots, Ball Marks and damage by shoes

Players should carefully repair any divot holes made by them and any damage to the putting green made by the impact of a ball (whether or not made by the player himself). On completion of the hole by all players in the group, damages to the putting green caused by golf shoes should be repaired

I love the pressure of this 2 day mixed formats. We had 58 players sign-up for 2 days of mixed format, competitive golf on two man teams. The highlight skins went to the team of Habermehl/Earhart who posted <u>eagle</u> on #17 Saturday and <u>eagle</u> on #4 Sunday. Kudos! In performing the audit I found several addition errors. These do not cause a penalty (rule 33.5) but do change the outcome. One of the errors was on a high placing team and after correction moved them from second to third. Please take the time to properly add your scores.

Special thanks to Kevin Knutson, Bruce Janke, Dennis and the rest of the El Prado staff for making this another successful tournament. Additionally I want to thank Mark Rief for helping on the Sunday scoreboard.
