Continuing Education (at least Junior Standing) Scholarships—due date May 1, 2024

Eligibility: junior standing or above, enrolled at an accredited college/university to complete bachelors or graduate degree, minimum 2.75 college GPA.

Class of 2023 (2nd Year) Scholarships due date July 1, 2024

Eligibility: student enrolled at an accredited institution, have earned a minimum 36 college level credits (quarter) or 24 college level credits (semester), minimum 2.75 college GPA.
