NEW YORK CITY TOUR: The all day New York City tour will take you from high (850') above Midtown, through Upper and Lower Manhatten. It includes the following:

"Top Of The Rock": Top of the Rock is a 55,000 square-foot, six-level complex that, for the first time in 20 years, offers visitors an unparalleled experience from which to enjoy vast, 360-degree views of New York City. The observation deck is atop the Art Deco skyscraper, 30 Rock. Views include some of the city's most prominent landmarks: The new "Freedom Tower" (One World Trade Center), the Empire State Building, the Chrysler Building, the Brooklyn Bridge, and from Central Park to the Hudson and East Rivers. There is a multi-media exhibit on the history of Rockefeller Center featuring contemporary plasma screens alongside an original basswood model of 30 Rockefeller Plaza. Sky shuttle elevators have projections on the glass ceiling showing images from 1930s through present day, symbolizing the passage of time, as they transport visitors to the deck. Outdoor observation decks in addition to indoor viewing areas with floor to ceiling windows. The observation deck was first opened to the public in 1933.

The New York City Tour continues with a guided bus tour of the Upper West Side and Central Park area.

"Grand Central Station": The historic Grand Central Terminal is a famous NYC landmark in Midtown Manhattan. Commonly referred to as 'Grand Central Station', it is loved by the world for its history, architecture and grandeur. It is one of the busiest train stations in the world. Built in 1871, it is home to some of the most beautiful Beaux-Arts architecture in NYC. Grand Central Station has undergone a number of renovations and restorations over the years. In the 1960's, this famous NYC landmark was nearly torn down, but with the help of first-lady Jacqueline Kennedy, it was designated as a historic American landmark. Renovations at the Grand Central Terminal were completed in 1998, and once more in 2007 when this NY landmark received an extensive cleaning revealing its magnificent ceiling. The Grand Central ceiling features a huge astronomical mural, a fact that was largely missed by Grand Central passengers for many years. Lunch is on your own at a wide variety of restaurants in the Dining Concours.

"9/11 Memorial & Museum": The whole afternoon is devoted to visiting the 9/11 Memorial (opened in 2011) and the 9/11 Museum (opened in 2014) that are located at "Ground Zero", the World Trade Center site. The 9/11 Memorial honors the people lost in the terrorist attacks of 9/11/2001 as well as those lost in the bombing on 2/26/1993. At this tribute and place of remembrance, their names are inscribed in bronze surrounding the two acre-sized reflecting pools located in the footprints of the twin towers. The 9/11 Museum tells the story of the events of 9/11 through artifacts that range in scale from the monumental to the intimate, as well as through first-person accounts and multimedia displays. While you're at the Memorial, a stop in the World Trade Center Transportation Hub (opened in 2016) and mall is also worthwhile.
