## Key Fobs

Your blue Seasonal Guest key fob will expire on November 1<sup>st</sup> 2018.

**Please do not** throw away or return your key fob, as it will be automatically reprogrammed for May 1<sup>st</sup> 2019.

**All guests will be required to vacate the park on or before November 1, 2018**

## Hydro Bills

The meters will be read next week so you should see them in your email by weeks end, Sept 7th. Please remember that we won't be able to take payments on Tuesday and Wednesday as will be on reduce hours by that time.

## Seasonal Guest Mail

- There is still quite a bit of mail for some Seasonal Guests in **Reception**, *some mail is even from the Spring.*

Please come check to see if you have any mail.

**We will be disposing of any mail left over as of November 1<sup>st</sup>.**

We will not hold onto this mail for the Winter.

## Golf Cart Storage

If you would like to take advantage of golf cart storage please come sign up in **Reception**. There are only 8 spots available, unless we get enough for a second trip. The cost is \$299.00 to store for the winter. Must be paid in advance.

## The Wash House

The Wash House will be available 24/7 for your convenience until **October 8, 2018**. The Washhouse will be available on weekends only until October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018. Washrooms will be available on weekends at the lodge while the Lakeside Grill is open.

## Winter Access to Cedar Cove Resort

From November to May, you are more than welcome to come check on your site. If you choose to do this, you must park your vehicle(s) in the main parking area in front of the **Lodge**, from there you will be able to walk up to your site.

No vehicles will be able to gain access to the park until the key fobs are reprogrammed for May 1<sup>st</sup>. We recommend doing any yard work/clean up, moving of large objects/furniture, taking down sun rooms, etc. before November 1<sup>st</sup> (when the key fobs expire) so you can have your vehicle at your site for easy transport of these items.

**Please keep in mind** that if you come to check your site this Winter, the Wash House will not be available, as the water in the park is off. Washroom access will only be available Friday-Sunday during the hours of operation of *The Lakeside Grill (see page 3 for Winter hours)*
