With it's "hyper kinetic" limbs, this old re-curve is both fast and incredibly accurate. Black limbs. Marblewood riser. Bow has no delamination; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No screw holes. No chips, dings or dents. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
