


Questionnaire Response - July 2017

She loves it here


Child always comes home happy and discusses what he did during the day

Keypeople helped settle child in, took a few weeks but he now just strolls in


Helped a lot in Lions Class but not in the Nursery Class when he wasn't allowed to bring in a toy from home as a comforter

Our keyperson policy and settling in policy treats each child and parent as an individual and enables us to work with you to make the settling in experience as easy and caring as possible, welcoming you into a new environment and supporting and getting to know you and your child's interests. Its such a shame that one child had a bad experience settling into Nursery Class – we do encourage transitional objects and comforters to help the separation basis, especially into the Nursery Class and feel sad that this child's object/s didn't help in this process



Preschool's Comments

Thank you for your kind comments. We are always available to speak to any parents to discuss problems, suggestions or indeed questions either by phone or in person, additionally you can contact Sian by email. Building relationships with keypersons is not only important for the children but the families also, siblings attending the preschool will (session/keyperson permitting) be assigned the same keyperson to hopefully build a good caring relationship. Start and end of the day is a busy time, however, please be reassured that we will make time for you, if you feel more comfortable you could always come earlier to pick up when it is quieter and more comfortable to speak more privately.

Child always tells us what snack and drink he has and it is always healthy and balanced


I assume s, are there any guidelines for lunches

Pre-school Comments

Weekly snack menus are always posted in the foyer above the white boards so you should always be aware of what snack your child is being offered. There could be a differentiation in what the classes are offered, the Nursery Class have snacks planned to aid their fine motor and manipulative skills such as spooning and spreading. Both classes have snacks planned in order for them to have a variety of fresh fruit to cut, carbohydrates such as pitta bread, wraps, breadsticks and dairy including cheeses, custard, yoghurt etc. Occasionally we may cook things to eat at snack or shop bought birthday cakes are brought in to celebrate as a treat, this is only given on one session and it is quite rare. Please look at the child's questionnaire responses to see what the children explained that they liked and you will see there is quite a variety. We also seek out dairy free, gluten free products for children who have allergies and that they can eat similar products alongside their peers. There are guidelines for parents regarding lunches – copies available


Thank you so much for your help and hard work for my child We didn't worry about our child at pre-school at all we know you all do and fantastic job for him and his friends

Pre-school Comments

Thank you for your lovely comments. Children's safety is one of our highest priority, I know sometimes it may feel quite rushed at picking up time as we bring each child to the door and this is where you as parents may feel we are not giving you attention to talk about your child's day. However, we have children going home, often with other carers or friends, children staying for lunch (so we need to supervise them accordingly), children transferring to Tigers, there is a lot of traffic and we want to ensure your child has their belongings and goes home to your arms safely. We ensure that all children in the garden have sun cream on and their heads are covered with a legionnaire style sunhat to protect their necks.

Very thorough


Yes we love to look at his book, all the photos and things he has done

Preschool Comments

Parent's evenings are conducted three times a year. Our planning is displayed in the Foyer, together with the sound of the week so that everyone can see our adult led activities and then all classes jot down on the whiteboard what your children have been doing during the session. Notes are put in the lunchboxes for you to be reassured with have assisted them and encouraged them to eat their lunch. Photographs of projects such as Easter, valentines, planting etc is also in the foyer for you all to look at. Unfortunately a creche is impossible due to all staff attending two nights with parents.

Thank you for your comments, the actual PIE evening is conducted once a year to give you the information you need, explain about the three classes, funding, transitions, the curriculum, show and tell, healthy eating. We want you to be prepared of the different transitions and what to expect in each class so that any worries or concerns can be aired and you feel confident that your child will receive the best possible care and education. I understand it is difficult especially with babysitting and work commitments to attend parent's evenings, however, with 80 families to accommodate we try and give plenty of notice of the dates we have planned in the newsletter.
