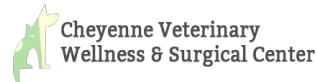

TIMING SYSTEM:

We are excited to announce that we are partnering with Big River Race Management this year for timing services! Runners will be issued a computer chip (integrated into the bib), to be worn on front of their shirts throughout the race. Special mats at the start and finish will record the time for each chip.

Space permitting, registration will continue online through and during registration on race morning.

COURSE:

Rolling out and back course along the famous Brentwood Fourth of July Parade route along Brownsville Road.

PRIZES:

All registered runners are eligible for the drawing. **Over \$2,000 in prizes to be raffled!** Race numbers will be drawn at random in Towne Square **DURING** the race and posted at the finish! **Winners MUST be present and sign for their prizes.**

Entry will supercede qualifying in any other divisions.*
